Pray for the nation of Sudan as the political upheaval of the last few months continues. Pray for peace and a just government to rule.

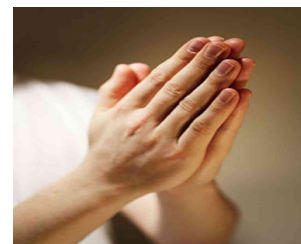
Give thanks for our local hospitals, state and private, and for all those who work in them. Pray for those working as hospital chaplains.
