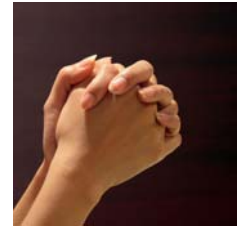
Please pray for our Easter services. Pray for preparations, and ask for new people to join us here in Waitara to hear the good news of Jesus and be saved.
